John Simmons of the other ^{part} witnesses that the s^d Wilkinson for & incon-
sideration of the sum of two hundred & twenty three pounds 19^s to the
said Wilkinson in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
that Bargained sold & delivered unto the s^d Simmons & to his heirs
forever a certain tract of land lying on the N^o side of Garrison
Creek containing by estimation one hundred & six acres be the same
same more or less & bounded as followeth. Beginning at a forked
poppler in a Branch near the mill pond in Logans Cocks line
thence along a line of marked trees to a pine thence to a large
live oak in a small branch in Simon Covetts line thence S. 66
degrees wt 22 pole to an oak thence along a line of marked trees
to another oak thence along a line of marked trees to a Gum
on the side of s^d Garrison Creek thence up the various courses of
the run of the s^d creek to the Swat house swamp thence up
