the s^d Robert Vaper & Sarah his wife for and in consideration of the sum
of three hundred pounds good & lawfull money of the state of Virginia
to them in hand paid by the s^d John Rochelle at and before the time
of signing sealing and delivery of these presents herewith
whereof they the s^d Robert Vaper & Sarah his wife doth hereby
acknowlege & themselves therewith fully satisfied contented &
paid both bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed & by these
presents doth hereby bargain sell alien enfeoff and forever confirm
unto the s^d John Rochelle his heirs & assigns two certain pieces lands
or parcels of land; one of them lying & being in the parish of
Stukes & county of Southampton on the south side of Notaway
River bounded as follows (towit) Beginning at two red oaks
standing on Notaway aforesaid corner trees of this tract and
Doctor Samuel Brown's thence aline of marked trees to
