year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and ninety between
Robert Vapser and Sarah his wife of the county of Hartford and state
of north Carolina of the one part and John Rockell of the county of
Southampton and state of Virginia of the other parts witnesseth that
the sd Robert Vapser & Sarah his wife for and in consideration of the sum
of three hundred pounds good & lawful money of the state of Virginia
to them in hand paid by the sd John Rockell at and before the
time of signing sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof they the sd Robert Vapser & Sarah his wife doth hereby
acknowledge & themselves therewith fully satisfied contented &
paid hath bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed & by these
presents doth hereby bargain sell alien enfeoff and forever confirm
unto the sd John Rockell his heirs & assigns two certain pieces tracts
or parcels of land; one of them lying & being in the parish of
St Lukes & county of Southampton on the south side of Notaway
River bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at two red oaks
standing on Notaway a preside corner trees of this tract and
Dater Samuel Brown's thence a line of marked trees to the
