This Indenture made this ninth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety two Between George Gurley of the county of Southampton & state of Virginia of the one part and John Gurley of the same place of the other part Witnesseth that the said George Gurley and in consideration of the natural affection he bears to his son John Gurley hath given granted and delivered to the s<sup>d</sup> John Gurley his heirs and assigns forever two tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the county of said one of which being the land the s<sup>d</sup> George Gurley purchased of Richard Vick containing by estimation one hundred and seventy five acres more or less. The other the land purchase of William Vick adjoining the former containing by estimation ninety four acres more or less which lands are so well known they need no further description which lands and tenements with all their appertinances and hereditaments whatsoever he the said George Gurley gives grants & assigns unto the said John Gurley To have and to hold
