This Indenture made this eighth day of March in the
year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & ninety two.
Between Martha Joyner John Woodard and Elizabeth his wife
Mary Joyner and Milisent Joyner of the county of Southampton
and parish of Netaway of the one part and William Williams the
younger of the county and parish aforesaid of the other part witnesseth
that the s^r Martha Joyner John Woodard & Elizabeth his wife Mary
Joyner and Milisent Joyner for and in consideration of the just and
full sum of eighty five pounds eleven shillings current money of Great
Britain by the s^r William Williams to them in hand paid before the en-
sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the s^r
Martha Joyner John Woodard and Elizabeth his wife Mary Joy-
ner and Milisent Joyner do hereby acknowledge and thereof ac-
quaint and discharge the s^r William Williams his heirs and
assigns for ever and themselves therewith fully and intirely satisfied
contented and paid they the s^r Martha Joyner John Woodard and
Elizabeth his wife Mary Joyner and Milisent Joyner have grant-
ed bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released set over delivered
and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien
enfeoff release set over deliver and confirm unto the s^r William
Williams & to his heirs and assigns for ever all that plantation
messuage tract and parcel of land late the property of J^r whereon
Lewis Joyner late of the county and parish aforesaid did live
situate lying and being in the county and parish aforesaid
near Netaway Swamp containing by estimation three hundred
and seventy five acres be the same more or less and being the lands
which the s^r Lewis Joyner Dec^d bought of Isaac Nelson by
indenture bearing date October 20th 1752. and granted to -
