year of our lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety two. between
Caleb Turner of the county of Southampton and parish of Netawney
of the one part and John Davis an inhabitant of Isaac Williams dec^d of
the county and parish aforesaid the other part witnesseth that the
s^d Caleb Turner for and in consideration of the just and full sum of
thirty pounds current money of Virginia by the s^d John Davis
to him in hand paid before the executing and delivery of these pre-
sents the receipt whereof the s^d Caleb Turner doth hereby acknowledge
and thereof acquit and discharge the s^d John Davis his heirs and
assigns for ever and himself therewith fully and intirely satis-
fied contented and paid he the s^d Caleb Turner hath granted bar-
gained sold aliened enfeoff released setover delivered and confirm
and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release
setover deliver and confirm unto the s^d John Davis and to his heirs
and assigns for ever all that plantation mesuige tract and parcel
