hundred acres on the following terms, to wit, that the s^r Nevitt Edwards at
his own cost whether bound the kitchen that no other land than what lies
on the south side of the plantation be aced by him during the time of
seven years from the first day of January next being the time of
when this lease expires & that he be allowed to tend all the ground cleared
within the last seven years, two years together: but afterwards neither
that cleared land nor the other cleared ground be tended only every other
year. on these terms I the s^r Nathan English lease unto the said
Nevitt Edwards his heirs &c. the s^r tract of land & plantation then
unto belonging for the term of seven years to commence on the
first day of Jan^y next ensuing the date hereof which land and
premises I the s^r Nathan English warrant and defend the use
thereof unto the s^r Nevitt Edwards his heirs and assigns during
the term of time aforesaid by these presents sealed with my seal
and dated this 8th day of October, 1792.
