doth grant bargain & sell unto the said Thomas Pete jun^r. & to his
heirs & assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the
county of Southampton on the north side of three creeks it being part of
three tracts of land which the s^d. Th^o. Pete the elder purchased of William
Moore, Parrillias Coffield & Howell Myrick containing in the whole
by estimation six hundred & twenty five acres be the same more
or less & bounded as followeth to wit. Beginning at a white oak stand-
ing on the bank of the north side of the three creeks being a corner
tree of the s^d. Pete & Henry Applewhite dec^d. thence down the various
courses of the run of the s^d. three creeks to a gum newly marked on the
bank of s^d. creek being a small distance above a pea field of s^d. Pete
thence along a new line north two degrees east one hundred and
eight pole to a pine near a branch, then along s^d. new line north
ten degrees east three hundred & eleven pole to a pine then a
long s^d. new line north twenty degrees west one hundred and
twelve pole to a red oak sapling in Howell Myrick's line near the cor-
ner of his cornfield then north eighty degrees west along Myrick's
