 in hand paid by the aforesaid Kinchen Turner the receipt whereof
 he doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained & sold & by
 these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the aforesaid Kinchen
 Turner & to his heirs & assigns forever all that tract or parcel of
 land which the aforesaid Sam^l Francis purchased of Benjamin
 Clifton containing by survey one hundred & twenty acres more
 less and bounded as followeth. Beginning at a gum by the side of
 herberts branch in Joshua Claudes line thence by the s^d Claudes
 line to Benj^m Claudes line thence along the s^d Benj^m Claudes
 line until it strikes the land formerly known by Col^l
 Thomas Williams and now Anthony Godwyns line thence
 along the s^d Godwyns line to George Irys line thence by the
 s^d Irys line until it strikes the west fork of herberts branch
