This Indenture made this thirteenth day of April one  
thousand seven hundred & ninety two. Between James Wilkison  
of the county of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part  
& Thomas Edmunds of the s<sup>d</sup> county and state aforesaid of the  
other part whereas the s<sup>d</sup> James Wilkison stands justly indebted  
unto the s<sup>d</sup> Tho<sup>s</sup> Edmunds in the full & just sum of three hun-  
dred & eighteen pounds one shilling & three pence current money  
of Virginia & being willing to secure the payment of the same with interest  
to the said Thomas Edmunds This Indenture Witnesseth that the said  
James Wilkison for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty shillings  
current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Thomas  
Edmunds the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge & for securing  
the Payment of the aforesaid sum of Three hundred & eighteen pounds  
one shilling & three pence with & without bargain & sale & by these pre-  
sents doth bargain & sell unto the said Thomas Edmunds his heirs & assigns  
Three separate Tracts or parcels of Land in the County of the same  
Tarranto Creek formerly the property of Benjamin Tucker situate containing  
Four hundred & eighty five acres or the same more or less bounded as follows  
to wit: Beginning at a bypress by the side of Tarranto Creek a corner to  
Edwards thence along his line to a Red oak thence the said Edwards  
line to a white oak thence along the said line to a pine in Saypoo Creek  
thence to a Gum in the Marsh Branch thence up the said  
Branch to the Quarter Branch thence down the said Branch to a  
Gum in John Wilkisons line thence along said line to a Red Oak  
thence along the said line to a white oak thence along the s<sup>d</sup> line  
to another white oak a corner of the s<sup>d</sup> Wilkisons line thence  
to a corner oak of Thomas Littmans line, by the s<sup>d</sup> Littmans line  
to a pine a corner of Robert Bryants Land thence along the  
Bryants line to a gum by the side of Tarranto Creek thence along  
down the various courses of the runs of the s<sup>d</sup> creek to the  
beginning the second seat tract or parcel of Land containing  
three hundred & seventy eight acres be the same more  
or less it being the lands & plantation sold to the late  
John Wilkison dec<sup>d</sup> by David Dawson & Ann his wife

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
