year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety one. Between
William Blunt & Elizabeth his wife of the county of Southampton
of the one part & William Little of the aforesaid county of the other
part witnesseth that the s^d William Blunt & Elizabeth his wife for
an inconsideration of the sum of two hundred & ninety one pounds
to the s^d Blunt in hand paid by the s^d Little the receipt whereof
of the s^d Blunt doth hereby acknowledge hath bargained sold and
confermed & by these presents doth bargain sell deliver & confirm
unto the s^d William Little a certain tract or parcel of land con-
taining by late survey five hundred & eighty two acres and
bounded by the lands of James Sandy Robert Mabry John
Myricks & Sandfords Landings (it being the land whereon the s^d
Little now resides) To have and to hold the s^d tract of land and
premises with the appertinances thereunto belonging unto the s^d William
Little his heirs & assigns for ever & the s^d William Blunt and
Elizabeth his wife doth for themselves and their heirs &c. forever warrant
and will forever defend the s^d title of the s^d Land and premises
unto the s^d William Little his heirs or assigns against all and
every person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming the same
or any part or parcel thereof. In witness whereof the s^d William
Blunt & Elizabeth his wife doth by these presents set their hands
