This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of March in the year of our lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & ninety two. —
Between Judkins Barham & Nancy his wife of the county of Wake and state of N. Carolina of the one part and Kinchen Jells of the aforesaid county & state of the other part witnesseth that the s. Judkins Barham and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings to him in hand paid by the s. Kinchen Jells the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the s. Judkins Barham and Nancy his wife hath granted bargained & sold aliened released and confirmed unto the s. Kinchen Jells to him & his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying & being in the county of Southampton on the north side of Notoway river containing four hundred & twenty five acres be the same more or less. Beginning at a small white oak corner of Joel Barham's land — s. 53° W. 36 pole to a pine in Moses Foster's line then S. 8° E 86½ pole to a persimmon bush a corner thence N. 24° E 86 pole to a red oak then N. 37° E 160 pole to a red oak N. 47° E 26 pole to a white oak a corner of the s. land then S. 66° E 32 pole to a white oak a corner of Fats land N. 35° E 132 pole to a pine then N. 3 E 58 pole to a red oak a corner of the s. land then N. 71° W 60 pole to a black oak in Watts line then S. 72° west 190 pole to a pine a corner in Tho. Williams line then N. 30° W. 112 pole to a pine a corner of the s. Land then S. 21° W. 74 pole to a red oak then S. 53° W. 18 pole to the road then across the s. road to Joel Barham's line and along the s. Barham's line to the beginning. To have and to hold the s. Tract or parcel of Land with all the ways waters & water courses with all the appertinances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the s. Kinchen Jells to be held by him & his heirs & assigns forever and the s. Judkins Barham & Nancy his wife for themselves & their heirs and all & every person or persons whatsoever claiming under them shall & will warrant and forever defend by their presents.
