This Indenture made the 4th day of December in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety two. Between John
Clayton of the county of Southampton of the one part and Eley Boykin
of the s^d county of the other part. witnesseth that the s^r John Clayton
for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds current mo-
ney of Virginia to him in hand paid by the s^r Eley Boykin at
or before the sealing and delivery of these presents
The receipt whereof the s^r John Clayton doth hereby acknowledge himself
fully satisfied & paid & whereof doth acquit & discharge the s^r Eley Boy-
kin his heirs & assigns forever by these presents hath granted bargained sold
& confirmed and by these presents doth granted bargained sell & confirm unto
the s^r Eley Boykin his heirs &c. one certain tract or parcel of Land con-
taining by estimation four hundred and thirty three acres be the same
more or less lying & being in the county aforesaid and bounded as follow-
eth Vizt. Beginning at a Maple a corner tree standing in the meadow
branch adjoining Solomon Holmes thence a line of marked trees to a pine
a corner tree adjoining Joseph Britts line of Land thence to a white
oak joining Edward Britts (a corner tree) thence to a red oak on the
east side of the rooty branch thence a line to a pine corner
tree
