unto the s^d Cook a certain tract of Land lying on the ne side of Tananow
creek in the county aforesaid containing by estimation three hundred
acres be the same more or less & bounded as followeth vizt beginning at
the mouth of the said house swamp thence up the various courses of the
run of the s^d swamp to a popple gum thence to a hickory standing
on the high land in Benjamin Grays line thence along a line of
marked trees to a lightwood stump a corner of the s^d Grays line
from thence to a hickory another corner from thence a straight line
to an oak on the side of the main road from thence to a white
oak in John Kindreds line thence along the s^d Kindreds line to
an ash a corner of Cordall Byrnum's line thence to the run of the
little swamp thence down the various courses of the run of the s^d
swamp to Tananow creek thence down the various courses of the
s^d creek to the begining To have & to hold the s^d tract of Land and
premises with all the appertinances thereunto belonging unto the s^d
Lazarus Cook & to his heirs forever and the s^d James Wilkison
for himself his heirs &c doth forever warrant and defend the title of the
same against all and every person or persons whatsoever in witness
