This Indenture made this 8th day of December in
the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety two.
Between James Barnes & Ann his wife of Southampton county &
state of Virginia of the one part & Nathan Williams of the county
& state afores^d of the other part witnesseth that the s^d James Barnes
& Ann his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
& sixty eight pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand
paid by the s^d Nathan Williams before the en sealing & delivering of
these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to be fully
satisfied & paid hath granted bargained & sold & doth by these
presents grant bargain and sell unto the s^d Nathan Williams
a tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the county aforesaid
situate on the south side of the cypress swamp containing by
estimation one hundred & forty acres be the same more or less and
bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a pine in the head of the
great branch thence west to a hickory saplin thence along the origina
mal line to a stump a corner of Jacob Williams thence along his
line to a pine a corner of the s^d Jacob Williams thence along the s^d
line to a gum the s^d Jacob Williams corner in the piney branch thence
up the s^d branch to the head thence along a line of mark^d trees to the
cypress road leading from the three cypress bridge on western
river to Browns bridge on Mathering river to a pine then across the
various courses of the s^d road to the great branch aforesaid then up the
various courses of the s^d branch to the beginning it being part of the
patent granted to Edward Barnes to hold the s^d land premises then
on or thereunto with appertinances unto the s^d Nathan Williams
his heirs & assigns forever & also the reversion & reversions remainen & re
mainden rents & services of all & singular the s^d premises & also the
right title interest property claim & demand of them the s^d James
Barnes & Ann his wife of in & to the same & s^d James Barnes & Ann
his wife for themselves their heirs exors. &c. doth covenant grant
