To all to whom these presents shall come know ye that I Benjamin Drew of Southampton county being possessed of a negro girl named Anna about six or seven years of age whom I purchased of John Taylor of this county & being willing & desirous to emancipate the ¹ Anna as by the laws of this commonwealth I am authorised therefore in conformity to the act of assembly in that case made & provided I do for my self my heirs executors & administrators emancipate & set free the ¹ Anna & I do hereby declare her to be forever discharged from slavery and I do further for myself my heirs executors & assigns disclaim all right title & Interest either to her person or any property she may hereafter acquire in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this the 20.th day of December in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety two
