granted bargained sold & delivered & doth by these presents grant
bargain sell & deliver unto the s^d Simon Pope a certain piece or
parcel of Land lying & being in the county aforesaid it being
in part of the tract of land the s^d James bought of Robert
Newsam containing by estimation twenty acres be the same
more or less & bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning in the
root/ branch or water course in s^d Simon Papes line thence
down
