 One thousand seven hundred and Ninety two Between James Barnes & Ann his  
 wife of the county of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part & Frederick  
 Roberson of the county of said Virginia of the one part & Frederick  
 Roberson his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred & fifty five  
 Pounds to him in hand paid by the said Frederick Roberson the receipt where  
 of the said James Barnes and Ann his wife acknowledge themselves fully  
 satisfied for One hundred & fifty five Acres of Land more or less (to be  
 lying) and being in the said County of Southampton bounded as follows  
 to wit Beginning at a pine at the side of the Great Pungo River somewhere  
 to a white oak in James Edwards Line from thence along James Edwards line  
 to a pine corner of London Vicks line thence along the s<sup>d</sup> London  
 Vicks line to Lewis Bryants line thence along the s<sup>d</sup> Bryants  
 line to James Edwards line thence along the s<sup>d</sup> James Edwards  
 line to the beginning. To have and to hold all & singular the  
 above bargained premises to him the s<sup>d</sup> Frederick Roberson his heirs  
 & assigns forever to the proper use and behoof of them & ever of them  
 & the s<sup>d</sup> James Barnes & Ann his wife at the time of sealing  
 & delivering of these presents and lawfully seized of the above land  
 with the appertinances therunto belonging in fee simple and the  
 the s<sup>d</sup> James Barnes & Ann my wife do for our selves our heirs &  
 assigns forever warrant and defend the s<sup>d</sup> land & premises against  
 all & all manner of persons laying any just title or claim there  
 unto & that the s<sup>d</sup> land is free & clear of all incumbrances
