their heirs forever nine Negroes Viz<sup>t</sup> Joe Steven Moses Tom Hannah  
& Giel ~~Beet~~ Phillis Judith & Sylvia also nine Horses including  
Mares & Colts with what goods remain on hand at the time  
of my decease. for the special purposes hereafter mentioned (Viz<sup>t</sup>)  
for payment of bonds & other accounts unto William Ureghart  
merchant in Southampton county also the balance of two bonds due  
James Wilkinson of s<sup>c</sup> county & Benjamin Williamson of the state of  
north carolina for pork purchased of them in the Spring 1792. also  
the money which may appear to be due from me to my sister  
Matthe Clements for her right in the property of the lands &  
negroes in Hampton &c. left her by her husband Tho<sup>s</sup>. Clements <sup>and</sup> to Rob<sup>t</sup>.  
Coche <sup>only</sup> also for the arrear of taxes due from me as collector of the s<sup>c</sup>  
taxes for the year 1787. to the commonwealth also one small debt  
due George Purdie Merchant in Smithfield also one small debt  
due John Jeffings Merchant in Petersburgh also one small debt  
due to Mr. Tho<sup>s</sup>. Lewis of Smithfield To have and to hold  
the aforesaid property consisting of nine negroes above named nine  
horses & what goods may be on hand at my decease  
to them & their heirs forever in special trust & confidence nevertheless  
to make sale of the s<sup>c</sup> property so vested in them & their heirs at such  
times & place as they may think most convenient to them & my  
wife Sarah Coche for the best price & such credit as may be most  
convenient to her & apply the money arising from such sale to the  
discharge of the forementioned debts only until they be discharged  
and the over plus (if any) shall be p<sup>d</sup>. by my s<sup>c</sup> trustees to my heirs  
and by them to my wife Sarah Coche in case there should not then  
exist any legal debts against <sup>my</sup> estate & the s<sup>c</sup> Matthew Coche
