in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred &
ninety three Between Simon Drake and his wife of
the county of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one
part & Samuel Hurt of the same county and state of the other
part witnesseth that the S^r Simon Drake &
Lucy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirteen
pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid
by the S^r Samuel Hurt at & before the signing sealing &
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the S^r Simon
Drake & Lucy his wife doth hereby acknowledge & themselves
therewith fully & satisfied contented & paid have bargained & sold
aliened enfeoffed & confirmed & by these presents doth hereby bar-
gain sell alien enfeoff & forever confirm unto the S^r Samuel Hurt
his heirs & assigns a certain tract plantation or parcel of Land
lying & being situate in the parish of Netoway & county of S^t.
ampton on the north side of flaggy run swamp Beginning
at a pine a corner tree of this tract & Barby Drake sen^r thence
S^r Samuel Hurts line party to these presents to a black oak in
George Washingtons sen^r line thence S^r Washingtons line to a pine
a corner tree of S^r Hurts tract & S^r Washingtons thence binding stile or
S^r Washingtons line to a sweet gum standing in a corner
a corner of William Washingtons thence his line to a pine
standing on the main road thence down the S^r road to the
first station containing by estimation thirty acres be the
same more or less together with all houses out houses &
