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A court held for the county of Southampton the 10th day of January 1793. This Indenture & the receipt thereon was acknowledged by Summers Drake & Lucy, his wife parties thereto she being first privately examined as the law directs & ordered to be recorded -

This Indenture made this thirteenth day of December in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & ninety two between Josiah Joyner of the parish of Notoway & County of Southampton of the one part & Nelson Wade of the same parish and county of the other part witnesseth that the S^r. Josiah Joyner for & in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds & three shillings current money of Eng^l to him in hand p^d. by the S^r. Nelson Wade the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge himself fully & amply satisfied p^d. hath granted bargained sold aliened released & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release & confirm unto the S^r. Nelson Wade his heirs & assigns all that plantation tract or parcel of Land & premises with the appertinances now in the Tenure & Occupation of the S^r. Nelson Wade to him his heirs & assigns situated lying & being in the afores^d. parish and county containing by estimation forty & one third acres be the same more or less & bounded as follows. Beginning at a gum a corner tree in Jacob Corbets line & running down a small branch to a gum from thence up another branch to a small gum in Johnsons Baines line from thence to a line of marked trees to four pines a corner of Johnsons Baines line from thence a straight line of marked trees to the first station and all houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards trees ways watercourses profits hereditaments & appertinances to the S^r. tract or parcel of Land belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the S^r. Josiah Joyner of in & to the same & every part
