This Indenture

made this 12th day of February in the year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three. Between James Barnes & Anne
Barnes of Virginia & County of Southampton of the one part & Arthur Whithead
of the same county & state afores. of the other part Witnesseth that the said James
Barnes & Anne his wife for & in consideration of the sum of two hundred and
fifteen pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand p. by the afores.
Arthur Whithead at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof we do truly acknowledge have granted bargained sold already
confirmed & by these presents do grant bargain sell & confirm unto the afores.
Arthur Whithead his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of
land lying & being in the county of Southampton & on the north side of Potomac
river containing two hundred & sixty seven acres more or less & bounded as fol-
loweth. Beginning on the run of the great branch at Pilgrim Vicks & Mills
Covetts line thence up the various courses of the branch to a pine in
Council Vicks line thence along this Vicks line to a black oak in
Dennis Simmons's line then along this Simmons's line to a pine in
Silas Vicks line thence along the S. Vicks line to a pine in John Jackson
line thence along the S. Jacksons line to a white oak in Jacob Vicks
line then along the S. Vicks line to a post oak in Mills Covetts line thence
along the S. Covetts line to the Beginning, and also the succession & reversions
remainder & remainders unto & services of the S. land & premises above mentioned
and every part & parcel thereof. To have and to hold all & singular the
land above mentioned & every part & parcel thereof with the appurtenances
unto the said Arthur Whithead his heirs & assigns forever & we the said James
Barnes & Anne his wife for our selves our heirs execs. & admors the Land
and premises and every part and parcel thereof and against all & every other
person or persons whatsoever shall & will warrant & forever defend clear & free
from all Incumbrances whatsoever. In witness whereof we have hereunto
