This Indenture made this 12th day of February in the year of
Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three. Between James Barnes & Anne
Barnes of Virginia & county of Southampton of thence part of Arthur Whitehead
of the same county & state aforesaid of the other part Witnesch that this James
Barnes & Anne his wife for & in consideration of the sum of two hundred and
fifteen pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the aforesaid
Arthur Whitehead at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold ^{deed} confirmed &
by these presents do grant bargain sell & confirm unto the aforesaid
Arthur Whitehead his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of
land lying & being in the County of Southampton & on the North side of Notaway
river containing two hundred & sixty seven acres more or less bounded as fol-
loweth. Beginning in the run of the great branch at Pilgrim Vicks & Hills
Bands line thence up the various courses of the branch to a pine in
Council Vicks line thence along this C. Vicks line to a black oak in
Demsy Simmon's line then along this. Simmon's line to a pine in
Silas Vicks line thence along the S. C. Vicks line to a pine in John Jackson
line thence along the S. C. Jackson's line to a white oak in Jacob Vicks
line then along the S. C. Vicks line to a post oak in Miles Everts line thence
along the S. C. Everts line to the Beginning, and also the reversion & reversions
remainders & remainders rents & services of the said land & premises above mentioned
and every part & parcel thereof. To have and to hold all & singular the said
land above mentioned & every part & parcel thereof with the appurtenances
unto the s. C. Arthur Whitehead his heirs & assigns forever & we the s. C. James
Barnes & Anne his wife for our selves our heirs executors administrators this Land
and premises and every part and parcel thereof and against all & every other
person or persons whatever shall & will warrant & forever defend clear & free
from all Incumbrances whatsoever. In witness whereof we have hereunto
