This Indenture made this tenth day of October in  
 the year one thousand seven hundred & ninety two between Howell  
 Vaughan & Rebecca his wife of the county of Southampton of the  
 one part and Benjamin Blunt of the other part Witnesseth that for  
 and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & forty four pounds 00<sup>00</sup>  
 currency to them in hand paid by the S<sup>d</sup> Blunt the receipt whereof  
 they themselves Howell Vaughan & Rebecca his wife do hereby acknowledge  
 have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell  
 unto the said Benjamin Blunt one certain tract or parcel of lands lying  
 and being in the county of Southampton containing by estimation two hun-  
 dred eighty eight acres and bounded as followeth (to wit) -  
 Beginning at a poplar on the side of Moses swamp a corner tree  
 in Moses Johnsons line thence along a line of Marked trees in the  
 said Johnsons line to a dead pine another corner tree in the said  
 line thence along the Johnsons line to a turkey oak a corner tree in  
 Benjamin Blunts line thence <sup>along</sup> a line of Marked trees in the S<sup>d</sup> Blunts  
 line to a pine a corner tree in Josiah Lopes line then straight for-  
 ward along the Lopes line to a pine a corner tree in Benjamin  
 Kindreds line thence along a line of Marked trees in the said  
 Kindreds line to the swamp thence up the various courses  
 of the run of this swamp to the Beginning with all houses or  
 charols woods ways waters & water courses privileges hereditaments  
 & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining  
 To have and to hold this granted land and premises to  
 the only proper use & behoof of him the said Benj<sup>n</sup> Blunt
