made this twelfth day of June in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & twenty three between Martha Windham of the county of Southampton of the one part and James Johnson of the same County of the other part witnesseth that the s^d Martha Windham in her in herse paid the receipt whereof the said Martha Windham doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge the s^d James Johnson by their parents have granted bargained and sold unto the s^d James Johnson by their doth grant bargain & sell unto the s^d James Johnson all his right and power in the lands of Eustace Windham deceased containing fifty eight acres more or less the aversion & reversion remainder & remainder issue & profits thereof and all the right title int^y property claim & demand whatsoever in the said Martha Windham of in & to the same To have and to hold the s^d land unto the s^d James Johnson forever & the s^d Martha Windham in this he do covenant promise & grant to defend the title of the s^d land unto the s^d James Johnson against all & every person & persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim shall & will warrant & forever defend the same by their parents & in witness whereof the s^d Martha Windham hath hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the day & year last above written
