At a court held for the County of Southampton the 13th day June 1793.
This Indenture and the receipt thereon was acknowledged by Abner Jones
Party thereto and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made the fourteenth day of June in the year of our
lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & ninety three Between Abner Jones & Fran-
cis his wife of the parish of Netley & County of Southampton of the one part & William
Jones of County & parish aforesaid of the other part Witnetheth that the s^d. Abner
Jones & Francis his wife for & in consideration of the just & full sum of forty
pounds current money of Eng^l by the s^d. William Jones to them in hand
paid at or before the enrolling & delivery of this presents the receipt whereof
they doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold aliened released and
confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release & confirm unto
the s^d. William Jones his heirs & assigns forever all that plantation & part of
the tract of land whereon James Wright formerly did live containing by
estimation sixty five acres more or less situated lying & being in County & parish of
aforesaid & bounded as follows (to wit) beginning at a red oak a corner tree of the Jones
thence along a line of market trees bearing east to a gum a corner in David Wrights line in a
branch thence down the various courses of s^d. branch to the indian field swamp thence
down the run of s^d. swamp to the small branch thence up the s^d. branch agree-
able to the old dividing to the first station and all houses out houses edifices
building woods ways water & water courses gardens orchards profits commodities
hereditaments thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining & the rents issues
& profits thereof & all the estate right title claim & demand of them the s^d. Abner
Jones & Francis his wife their heirs & assigns forever after & to the same end
every part or parcel thereof & all deeds & writings touching or concerning the same
To have and to hold the mesuage tract & parcel of sixty five acres of land.
