This Indenture made this 22nd day of Apr: in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three between Eliza Landford of the County of Southampton & State of Virg: of the one part & Will: Pope of the County & State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the S^r. Eliza Landford for & in consideration of the sum of two hundred & sixteen pounds current money of Virg: to her in hand paid the receipt whereof the S^r. Eliza Landford doth hereby acknowledge & herself therewith fully & entirely satisfied, contented & paid the S^r. Eliza Landford have bargained sold - allowed in full & confirmed & by these presents doth bargain, sell alien enfull & confirm unto the S^r. Will: Pope to him his heirs & assigns forever three small tracts or parcels of land lying & being in Notoway parish & County of S^c.ampton the high land called the Orchard tract is bounded as followeth. Beginning at a white oak a corner tree in John Lawrences line thence S. 2^d west to the cy press swamp thence up the swamp to Thomas Mountfords line then along the S^r. Mountfords line to the cut line then to the first station. The second piece is the tract called the Island not exceeding a mile distance Joining on Black water river begining where the river branch makes into the Island then down the S^r. branch to the cy press swamp then down the S^r. swamp on Joshua Diners line to Black water then up Black Black Water to G. Thos Whites line then along the S^r. Whites line on the high land joining the Island to the river branch to the first station. The third being the lands that Tho: Landford bought of Will: Glover & given to his son Eliza Landford partly to their parents in his will containing in both S^r. tracts by estimation one hundred & eighty acres be the same more or less. The third piece being the tract that Tho: Landford bought of Wade Mountford & also given to his son Eliza Landford & be undeed as followeth (to wit) beginning at the mouth of Sacks branch where it makes into the cy press swamp then running the water course of the S^r. branch on Thos Joyners line till it makes out the S^r. branch on the right hand to a red oak a marked tree thence a line of marked trees on the S^r. Joyners line to a red oak a corner tree then

standing
