This Indenture made this ninth day of May one thousand seven hundred & ninety three between Philiman Wattfield & Williams Bick of Southampton county witnesseth that the S^r Philiman Wattfield for & in consideration of the sum of three pounds current money of Eng^l hath granted & confirmed and by these presents doth for ever grant & confirm unto the Williams Bick his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land in the county aforesaid on the south side of Arthur's swamp six acres be the same more or less bounded as follows Beginning at a gum in the S^r swamp a corner tree of the S^r Wattfield land thence by the S^r Williams Bick own line to a pine a corner tree of Benjⁿ Jordan land thence by the S^r Benjⁿ Jordan line to a small branch thence down the various courses of the run of the S^r branch to the S^r swamp thence up the various courses of the run of the said swamp to the beginning together with all houses out houses ways waters & water courses woods & underwoods vines and meadows & all other the profits & commodities thereof belonging or in anywise appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the S^r premises with the appurtenances unto the S^r Williams Bick his heirs & assigns for with the reversion & reversions remain & demand remainders rents issues & profits thereof & every part thereof & the said Philiman Wattfield for himself his heirs executors and assigns doth covenant & agree with the S^r Williams Bick his heirs & assigns in the following manner that is to say that the S^r Philiman Wattfield at the time of signing and sealing these presents is lawfully seized and possessed of the bargained premises in good and pure estate in fee simple and that the same is fully and clearly acquitted of & free from all former gifts grants deeds mortgages & debts and incumbrances and of and from all manner of incumbrances
