This Indenture made the twenty first day of March in the year four Last one thousand seven hundred & ninety three Between Miss Booth just & Sarah his wife of the one part & Moses Booth just of the other Witnesseth that the s^d Moses Booth just & Sarah his wife for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & eighty pounds current money of Eng^l to him in hand paid by the s^d Moses Booth just at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the s^d Miss Booth just doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge the s^d Moses Booth just his heirs & assigns have granted bargain & sold alien release & confirm and by these presents do grant bargain & sell alien release & confirm unto the s^d Moses Booth just his heirs & assigns all that plantation tract or parcel of land whereon the s^d Moses Booth just now lives (except) three acres sold to Sampson Stanton & adjoining his mill containing by estimation three hundred & twenty two acres (inclusive of the three acres above mentioned) be the same more or less part of which land s^d to contain two hundred and twenty acres was devised by Robert Booth the father to his son Robert Booth and by him & by him to his son Moses Booth just party hereto the residue thereof (out of which the three acres above mentioned are excepted) —
