The Commonwealth of Virginia to Edm. Tyler & Robert Goodwyn
Gentlemen greeting whereas Anne Booth j^r & Sarah her wife have by their certain indenture
of bargain & sale dated the 21st day of March 1793 sold & conveyed unto Moses Booth w^t
of the county of Southampton the fee simple estate of & in one certain tract or parcel of land
containing by estimation three hundred & twenty two acres & whereas the s^d Sarah cannot
conveniently travel to the court of our s^d County to make acknowledgement of the same
We therefore command you or any two of you that you go personally to the s^d Sarah Booth
& examine her privately & apart from her husband whether she has executed the s^d deed
freely & voluntarily without the persuasion or threats of her s^d husband & whether she
is willing the same should be recorded in the court of our s^d County of Southampton & when
you have examined her as afores^d & taken her acknowledgement of the s^d indenture
that you distinctly & plainly certify us thereof under your hands and seals returning
to us also this writ with the indenture examined within 40 days after the date of our said
court at the office the 20th day of March 1793 (and in the 17 year of
the Commonwealth.
