This Indenture made the 12th day of January anno Dom 1793 between
 Thomas Holladay of the one part & Benjamin Turner & Wright Griffin of the other
 part witnesseth that whereas the s^d Tho^s Holladay has a claim in right of his wife to
 the following negroes viz. Lelia, Andrew, son of Abraham James Alexander China &
 Anne of which negroes Samuel Griffin son of the s^d Samuel Griffin & which were the
 slaves of his s^d wife who was formerly the wife of the s^d Samuel Griffin, now the said
 Benjamin Turner & Wright Griffin for & in consideration of a relinquishment made
 by the s^d Tho^s Holladay of his claim to the s^d negroes in right of slaves of his s^d
 wife having granted alms & confirmed & by their presents do grant alms & confirm
 unto the s^d Tho^s Holladay in his own behalf the following negroes viz. Rachel
 and Joseph & also to the s^d Tho^s Holladay guardian to his son Thomas Holladay
 the following slaves viz. Andrew son & her child Tho^s & David all which slaves
 were of the estate of Samuel Griffin just died & of which estate the said Benjamin
 Turner & Wright Griffin are distributors To have & to hold the s^d slaves by their
 presents granted alms & confirmed to the s^d Tho^s Holladay his heirs execs or
 assigns forever & to have & to hold above named slaves to the s^d Tho^s Holladay guardian
 in trust for his son Tho^s Holladay just forever & the s^d Ben^g Turner & Wright
 Griffin our heirs execs admors unto the s^d Tho^s Holladay in his own behalf
 his heirs execs or admors. and to the s^d Tho^s Holladay as guardian &c. shall bind
 with warrant & forever defend the s^d slaves by their presents against them the s^d Ben^g
 Turner & Wright Griffin & their heirs execs admors of which negroes on the s^d Ben^g
 Turner & Wright Griffin have put the s^d Tho^s Holladay in possession by deli-
 vering them at the sealing of their presents In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands
 & seals this 12th day of Jan^y anno Dom 1793.
