ney of Virg^a to me in hand paid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
have granted bargained & sold and by these presents doth bargain & sell and
acknowledge to be in the possession of Tho^s. Holladay Jun^r of Southampton County
in Virg^a one negro man Abraham which the s^d negro Abraham to
have & to hold the s^d negro man Abraham unto the s^d Tho^s. Holladay Jun^r
his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby forever warrant and defend the
title of the s^d negro from the claim and demand of every other person or
persons whatsoever unto the s^d Thomas Holladay Jun^r his heirs and
assigns In witness whereof the s^d Wright Griffin have hereunto set my
hand & seal this nineteenth day of Jan^y one thousand seven hundred &
ninety three -

This Indenture made this thutenth day of June anno Dom one thousand
seven hundred & ninety three. between Will^m. Thomas Jun^r of Sth. Below at Ch^y. Lawsons
and Richard Below comorpiners as having after mention of the one part and
Jⁿ. Richelle of the county of Southampton of the other part. Witnesseth
that whereas a decree of the county Court of Southampton made at the North
Quarterly session anno Dom. 1792 hath directed a site to be made of
a tract of land lying in the county afores^d and formerly belonging to the es-
tate of Jⁿ. Vachon Dec^d & hath appointed the above mentioned William
Thomas
