This Indenture made this 20th day of October one thousand seven hundred and ninety two. between Richard Harrison of Southampton County State of Virg^a and ninety two. between Richard Harrison of Southampton County State of Virg^a as the 1st Richard Harrison stands indebted to the 2^d J. S. Harrison in the sum of two thousand five hundred & twenty two pounds six shillings & six pence current money of Virginia & being willing & desirous to secure the payment thereof by mortgaging certain effects of the 1st Richard Harrison to the 2^d James Harrison. Now this Indenture W^{it} testeth that as well for securing the above mentioned sum & being thereon as for the consideration of five shillings to the 1st Richard Harrison in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the 1st Richard Harrison hath bargained & sold & by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the 2^d James Harrison & to his assigns the following Articles now in the possession of the 1st Richard Harrison (W^{it}) two hundred & thirty five acres of land more or less lying & being in the county of Southampton wherein the said Richard Harrison now resides also eighteen negroes with their names as follows: Will, Mitty, Sundry, Filly, Lucy, Cherry, Jane, Lamm, Ann, Tott, Dick, Peter, Jack, Ned, Isaac, Lydia, Cherry & Nell & their future increase four feather Beds & Furniture six Heads of Horses twenty eight head of Cattle one yoke of steers & about twenty head of Sheep ninety ^{two} head of hogs one riding chair & harness one smooth bore Gun crop of corn Tobacco and Cotton & all the rest of my household & kitchen Furniture and plantation Utensils. To have and to hold the above bargained articles unto the 2^d James Harrison to his use and behoof forever provided always that this Indenture is upon this condition that if the said Richard Harrison do & shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the 2^d James Harrison the said sum of two thousand five hundred & twenty two pounds six shillings and six pence on or before the 25th day of December next ensuing the date hereof that then this Indenture & every thing therein contained shall cease & determine
