 This Indenture made this tenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three between William Urguhart of Southampton of the one part & John Urguhart of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the S^r William Urguhart for & in consideration of the love & affection he bears to the S^r John Urguhart as well for the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the S^r John Urguhart the receipt whereof the S^r William Urguhart doth hereby acknowledged & thereof acquit and discharge the S^r John Urguhart his heirs & assigns forever granted bargained & sold & doth by these presents grant bargain & sell unto the S^r John Urguhart that part of the Land whereon the S^r William Urguhart now lives which lies on the south side of the main Road leading from Broad water to Southampton Court house being part of the Land the S^r William Urguhart bought of John Ingram & part of that bought of Charles Barrett also a new survey of thirty one acres & also the following Slaves Right Peter Milly Sarah Sam Milly Rose Silvia Ephraim Dinah Willig Tife Jack Rachelle Billy Tom Jacob Dany & Joshua To have and to hold the above Land & Slaves to him the S^r John Urguhart his heirs or assigns forever And the S^r W^m Urguhart for himself his heirs & assigns doth by these warrant & defend unto the S^r Jⁿ Urguhart for himself his heirs & assigns the above Land & Slaves against the Claim of all persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the S^r W^m Urguhart hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the day & Year above mentioned
