Sendeth greeting knowing that the said David Burn for divers causes and valuable considera-
tions mo Recounting moving but more especially for and in consideration of the natural love and
affection which he have & bear unto my son Thom Burn have given granted & confirmed
By these presents do give grant & confirm unto my son Thom Burn one Horse & one
cart & four two Flock Hens & Plus all my three makers Tools & Last One wedding Hoe & Win-
hoe Two Trunks & Chest One Pot & Pan in possession & Estate of Inheritance in fee simple
& the said David Burn all & Singular the appurtenances before given & granted
& these Premises with all & Singular the appurtenances as aforesaid unto the said Thom
Burn his heirs & assigns forever against all persons whatsoever shall & law warrant
and forever defend by these presents defend In Witnes whereof the said David Burn
hath set his hand & seal this 28th day of February 1793

This Indenture made the eighth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and eighty six between Edwin Gray and Juliana his wife of the one part and Jesse Barrell
of the other. Witnesseth that the said Edwin Gray and Juliana his wife for and in consideration of
the sum of Two hundred and twenty five pounds current money to them in hand paid by the said
Jesse Barrell the receipt whereof the said Edwin Gray doth hereby acknowledge they the said Edwin
Gray and Juliana his wife hath granted, bargained and sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed and
by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell, alien, convey and confirm unto the said Jesse Barrell
his heirs and assigns for ever, one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation two hundred
and ninety five acres betwixt the same more or less situated lying and being on the North side of the lightwood
swamp in the County of Southampton and bounded as followeth to wit: Beginning at a poplar in
the poplar branch in Moses Booths line then by a line of marked trees to a turkey oak a corner betwixt
in said Booths line thence by a line of John Bailey's (now Charles Bailey's) to the babbin
branch to a poplar in the said Bailey's line thence up the babbin branch to a pine in the pasture
