This Indenture made the fifth day of August in the year our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred Ninety three Between Richard Markes junr of the county of Southampton of the one part & John Markes of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Markes junr for and in consideration of the sum of Forty Pounds current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Markes before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof the said Richard Markes junr doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said John Markes his heirs and assigns forever a certain Tract or parcel of land lying and being in the said County of Southampton containing by estimation Fifty Seven Acres be the same more or less it being half of my tract of Land bounded as in my deed including part of the plantation whereon I now live and the Reversion & Remainder & Remainders Rents Issues & Profits thereof and also all the Estate right Title claim & Demand of him the said Richard Markes junr his heirs & assigns to the same for and to have and to hold the said Land & Premises with all & singular the Appurtenances thereunto the said Richard Markes junr his heirs and assigns forever To the only proper use & behoof of the said John Markes his heirs and assigns forever And the said Richard Markes junr his heirs Executors & Assigns with Covenant Promise & Grant to the said John Markes his heirs and assigns by these presents that the said Richard Markes the said Land & Premises and every part & parcel thereof unto the said John Markes his heirs & assigns against the Lawful claim Title Demand of the said Richard Markes his heirs & assigns or any other person & persons whatsoever shall & will Warrent & forever defend by these In Witnesses whereof the said Richard Markes hath hereunto set his hand and Affixed his seal the day & Year above Written

This Indenture of two parts, made & entered into between Sampson Pitman of the one part & Melchizedek Pitman of the other both of the County of St. in the Colony of Virginia Christ One thousand Seven hundred & Ninety three On the 12 day of September Witnesseth that the said Sampson Pitman for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings to him in hand paid by the said Melchizedek Pitman before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Sampson Pitman doth hereby acknowledge & accepts as well for and in consideration of the natural love & affection of him the said Sampson Pitman to the said Melchizedek Pitman hath bargained granted & sold unto the said Melchizedek Pitman his heirs & assigns all that tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Southampton and Parish of Mattoway containing by estimation two hundred & thirty seven Acres lying
