This Indenture made this 27 day of July in the year of our Lord 1793 Between
 Nathan Williams & Polly his wife of the county of Stm & State of Virg^a of the one part & Benj^a
 Barnett of the said County & State of the other part Witnesseth that the s^d Nathan Williams
 for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen pounds current money of Virg^a to him in hand
 paid by the said Benj^a Barnett before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged to be fully satisfied & paid hath granted bargained & sold
 Vastly by these presents grant bargain & sell unto the said Benj^a Barnett a Tract & parcel
 of Land lying & being in the parish of Pluke in the county afores^d & situate on the path
 side of the Cypress Swamp containing by estimation thirty acres by the same more less and
 measured as follows to wit: Beginning at a pine a corner in Nathan Barnes line thence
 along the said line to a white Oak in the patent line thence along the Patent line to a Cherry
 in Benj^a Barretts line thence along the various courses of the road that leads from the
 Cypress Bridge on Nottoway to Barnes Bridge on Ucheverin to the Beginning part of a
 Patent granted to Edwards Barnes dated the 15th day of Dec^r 1749 to hold the said land & pre-
 mises thereon or thereupon with appurtenances unto the s^d Benj^a Barnett his heirs & assigns
 forever & all the reversion or reversions remainder Term and divers rents & Services of all &
 singular the s^d Premises & all the right title Interest Property claim Demand and give
 the s^d Nathan Williams & wife Polly of in & to the same like s^d Nathan Williams & wife Polly
