This Indenture made the Twenty fourth day of May in the year of our Lord 1773 Between Thomas Litch Senior of Brunswick County of the one part & Mark Nicholson of St^r County of the other part Witnesseth That the s^d Tho^s Litch in consideration of the natural love & affection which he hath beareth unto the said Mark Nicholson as his son in Law & his children George the Grand Children of the s^d Tho^s Litch & for & toward their better maintenance & Support in the world. Let the s^d Thomas Litch hath given granted aliased & confirmed unto the said Mark Nicholson his heirs and assigns & by these presents doth give grant alien & confirm unto the said Mark Nicholson his heirs and assigns forever Three Negro Slaves to wit Tom, Aggy & Olden, which now are & shall for several years last past been in the possession of the said Mark Nicholson together with all the said Aggy's future increase. To have and to hold unto the said Mark Nicholson his heirs & assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Mark Nicholson his heirs and assigns forever In Witness whereof the said Thomas Litch hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & year above written

With given & granted & with by these presents Give grant & confirm unto the said Lewis Warrell a certain Tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County aforesaid it being the tract of land wherein the said Ephraim Williams & Mary his wife now lives or containing by Estimation 150 acres more or less & bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a red oak in Benjⁿ Barretts line thence along a line of mark & trees to a lightwood Post in Jacob Williams line thence along the said Williams line to a Hickory & corner of the s^d Williams thence along to a corner of a Turkey Oak in Joel Edwards line thence along the s^d Edwards line to a White oak in a prong of the Little Swamp thence up the s^d Swamp to a black Gum in John Barretts line thence along a line of mark & trees to the Beginning To have and to hold the s^d land & premises therein with appurtenances unto the said Lewis Warrell his heirs & assigns forever - And the Remainder & Residues remain & remainders unto & services of all & singular the said Premises & Parts all the right Little Swamp
