To all People unto whom these present Writing shall come that we Ephraim Williams and Mary his wife of the County of Phamptn Virg - do v in consideration of the love good will and affections that we the said Ephraim Williams & Mary his wife do have & bear unto their Neibor Lewis Worrill of the said County & State hath given & do grant unto him & his heirs & assigns a tract of land lying & being in the County aforesaid it being the tract of land wherein the said Ephraim Williams & Mary his wife now lies on containing by estimation 15 acres more or less bounded as follows (so w't) Beginning at a red oak in Benj' Barretts line thence along a line of mark'd trees to a lightwood post in Jacob Williams line thence along the said Williams line to a Hickory a corner of the s<sup>t</sup> William's thence along to a corner a Turkey Oak in Jollards line thence along the s<sup>t</sup> Edwards line to a Willo oak in a grove of the Little Swamp thence up the s<sup>t</sup> swamp to a Black Gum in Jepa Barretts line thence along a line of mark'd trees to the Beginning To have and to hold the s<sup>t</sup> land & premises therein with appurtenances unto the said Lewis Worrill his heirs & assigns forever - And the Rvrsion & payment of all m<sup>r</sup>ainours rents & charges of all & singular the said Premises & all the freight & taxes
