This Indenture made the 12 day of Feb<sup>r</sup> 1793 Between Jacob Bailey & Amy his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Vir<sup>g</sup> of the one part & Robert Daughtrey of the same County & State of the other part (Witnesseth) that the said Jacob Bailey & Amy his wife for in consideration of the sum of Thirty Three pounds three Shillings & Six pence half Penny viz<sup>a</sup> of these presents the receipt whereof the said Jacob Bailey & Amy his wife doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge the said Robert Daughtrey his heirs Executors & assigns by these presents they the said Jacob Bailey & Amy his wife have granted bargain & sold aliened Released & confirm'd and by these presents do grant sell Alien Release & confirm unto the said Robert Daughtrey or or his heirs & assigns forever a tract or parcel of land lying & being on the South side of Nottingham River in the County aforesaid containing Thirty three & three quarter acres and bounded as followeth (To wit) Beginning at poplar in the side of a small branch thence Southwesterly 61 Pole to a Hickory thence Easterly 79 Pole to a Poplar in the side of a small branch thence Northwesterly 64 Pole to a Gum in the side of a small branch thence over the branch 20 paces to a lightwood Post in W<sup>m</sup> Edwards line thence Westerly a long Edwards line to a white oak in the side of a small branch thence down the run of the said branch to the beginning with all woods underwoods Trees ways water & water courses low grounds or a down profits Commodities & appurtenances whatsoever belonging to the said tract or parcel of land & premises belonging or in any way appertaining To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises to the only proper use & behoof of the said Robert Daughtrey his heirs or assigns forever & the s<sup>r</sup> Jacob Bailey & Amy his wife for themselves their heirs Executors & assigns do truly covenant & grant to & with the said Robert Daughtrey his heirs Executors & assigns in manner & form following that is to say that the s<sup>r</sup> Robert Daughtrey his heirs and assigns shall & may at all times forever hereafter peaceably have hold & occupy possess all & singular the said thirty three & three quarter acres of land & premises as aforesaid with the appurtenances without the least trouble hindrance or molestances or disturbance of all & every Person or persons whatsoever & further that the s<sup>r</sup> Jacob Bailey & Amy his wife & all persons claiming or to claim by force or under them any thing in the premises above mentioned or in any part thereof shall & will from time to time at all times hereafter upon the reasonable request & at the costs & charge of the s<sup>r</sup> Robert Daughtrey his heirs & assigns make do & execute or cause to be done or Executed & every such further & other lawful & reasonable act & acts thing & things devised & conveyances in the law whatsoever for the further better & more perfect granted conveying & enjoying of all & singular the premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said Robert Daughtrey his heirs & assigns as by the s<sup>r</sup> Jacob Bailey his heirs & assigns or his or their Council learned in the Law shall be lawfully advised and devised or required - And Lastly that the said Jacob Bailey & Amy his wife & their heirs the above granted premises & every part & parcel thereof unto the said Robert Daughtrey his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims titles & demands of all & every Person or persons what soever shall and will warrant & never defend by these presents the Writs whereof the said Jacob Bailey & Amy his wife hath to these presents at these hands & seals the day & year above written Signed Sealed & delivered in presence of
