 Justices of the Peace of the county of Ston. Greeting whereas Tho^d Holladay & Mary his wife
 by their certain indenture of bargain & sale bearing date the 26 day of June in the year
 of our Lord 1793 have sold & conveyed unto Tho^d Turner the fee simple estate of about 6 1/2
 acres of Land lying & being in the county of Ston. And whereas the said Mary cannot
 conveniently travel to the court of the s^d county of Ston to make acknowledgment of the
 said conveyance therefore we do give unto you or any two or more of you power to receive
 the acknowledgment which the said Mary shall be willing to make before you of the
 conveyance aforesaid contained in the s^d Indenture which is hereto annexed
 And we do therefore command you that you do personally go to the s^d Mary & receive her
 acknowledgement of the same & examine her privily & apart from the s^d Tho^d Holladay
