

the simple estate of and Three hundred & few acres of Land lying & being in the county of Kent  
 And whereas the said Mary cannot conveniently travel to Court of the sd county of Kent  
 make acknowledgement of this said conveyance. Therefore we do give unto you or any two or  
 more of you power to receive the acknowledgement which the said Mary shall be willing to  
 make before you of the conveyance aforesaid contain'd in the said deed of gift which is hereunto  
 annexed. And we do therefore command you that you do personally go to the sd Mary and  
 receive her acknowledgement of the same, & examine her Privily & a part from the sd Thomas  
 Holladay her husband whether she doth the same freely & voluntarily without his persuasion  
 or threats & whether she be willing the same should be recorded in the court of our said  
 county. And when you have receiv'd her acknowledgement & examin'd her as aforesaid  
 that you distinctly and openly certify us thereof in our said court under your hands  
 and Seals sending then thence the said deed of gift & this writ with you. Held at our  
 Court at his office the 8th day of July 1793 in the 13 year of the commonwealth

In Obedience to the within writ to us directed we did personally apply to Mary Holladay  
 wife of Tho<sup>s</sup> Holladay before us she did acknowledge the indenture hereunto annexed &  
 relating to her right of dower to the land in the sd Indenture mentioned (which  
 separate & a part from her husband) she did the same freely willingly & without the  
 persuasion or threats of her husband of which we do hereby certify the justices of the  
 county court of Kent under our hands & Seals this 2<sup>d</sup> day of July 1793. P<sup>d</sup> The sd  
 Mary doth consent that the said Indenture should be recorded in the said county  
 Court of Kent at Hampton

 the Privy Examination of Mary Holladay the wife of the sd Thomas Holladay  
 & the certificate of the Execution thereof were ordered to be recorded

This Indenture made the 18 day of April in the year of our Lord 1793 Between J<sup>n</sup>  
 P<sup>d</sup> of the County of Kent of the one part & Nathaniel P<sup>d</sup> of the sd County of Kent  
 Witnesseth that the said J<sup>n</sup> P<sup>d</sup> for & in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds and  
 money of Ving<sup>s</sup> to him in hand paid by the said Nathaniel P<sup>d</sup> the receipt  
 whereof the sd J<sup>n</sup> P<sup>d</sup> doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain'd & sold  
 Alien'd Enjoyn'd & confirm'd by these presents doth grant bargain & sell  
 Enjoyn'd & confirm unto the said Nathaniel P<sup>d</sup> his heirs & assigns forever
