lives on and bounded as follows beginning at a pine a corner Tree on the south side of Britain Tavis  
land thence along a line that John Windham made to a pine in the head of the long branch a  
corner tree thence up a slash to a white oak a corner tree that John Windham made thence a  
long a new made line to the Hasper branch to a pine a corner Tree thence down that branch  
to a poplar joining Nathaniel Withens land thence along the Patent line to a white oak in  
Ansulman Jones land thence along a line to the beginning Which by these presents I do fully  
give to him the said Gylan Tavis his heirs and assigns forever To have & to hold the premises  
with the appurtenances thereunto belonging to him the said Gylan Tavis his heirs & assigns forever  
to their own proper use & behoof absolutely without any manner of condition In Witness whereof I have  
hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 15 day of April 1793.

the one part & James Wilkinson of the other Witnesseth that the said Newsum for full consideration  
of the sum of £30 pounds doth in hand paid the receipt is hereby acknowledged & hath bargained  
sold & confirmed unto the said James Wilkinson his heirs &c a certain tract or parcel of land  
lying in the county of Stan & in the parish of Liches containing by estimation 100 acres  
be the same more or less bounded as followeth Viz partly by the northern & quarter line  
of marsh trees & Caligon new line dividing the same from the land the property of Joel Newsum  
which is 100 acres was set apart as Patience Newsums dower by Mr Thomas Hoarley the  
said Joel Newsum & Sarah his wife doth by these presents for themselves their heirs &c grant the same  
unto the said Wilkinson & his heirs forever In Witness whereof the said Newsum & wife both have  
set their hands & affixed their seals this day & year above written
