This Indenture made this 12 day of September in the year of our said Lord Christ 1793 between  
 Barnaby Drake Son & Mary his wife of the county of Stan & State of Virg<sup>a</sup> of the one part & Mourning  
 & Patty Drake of the same county & state of the other part Witnesses that the said Barnaby  
 Drake Son & Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of 200 current money of the state of Virg<sup>a</sup>  
 to them in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup> Mourning & Patty Drake at & before the signing sealing & delivery of  
 these presents the receipt whereof the said Barnaby Drake & Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge  
 & themselves therewith fully satisfied contented & paid have bargained & sold by these presents doth  
 hereby bargain sell alien assign & convey unto the said Mourning & Patty Drake their heirs  
 & assigns a certain pt<sup>l</sup> or parcel of land containing by estimation 14 acres be the same more or less bound  
 ed as follows Viz beginning at a person or bush on the S<sup>th</sup> Barnaby Drakes field thence a line of  
 new marked trees to a large pine a dividing line between said Barnaby Drake & Lemuel Hart  
 thence up said line to a small red oak bush on the edge of the said Lemuel Harts old field from  
 thence a straight course to the beginning place together with all houses with houses gardens orchards  
 ways mines & minerals & all other the profits & commodities thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining  
 To have and to hold the s<sup>d</sup> bargain'd premises with every of the appurtes unto the said Mourning  
 & Patty Drake their heirs & assigns forever to the only proper use & behoof of the said Mourning & Patty  
 Drake their heirs & assigns lawfully with the exception & reservation remainder & remainder & rents profits  
 & profits thereof any part & parcel thereof And the said Barnaby Drake Son & Mary his wife for them  
 selves their heirs Executors & assigns doth covenant & agree to & with the s<sup>d</sup> Mourning & Patty Drake that  
 at the time of signing & sealing of these presents that they the said Barnaby Drake Son & Mary his wife  
 stands lawfully seized & possessed of in & to the said bargain'd premises in a good & true estate free  
 simple & that the same is fully freely & clearly acquitted & discharged of from all manner of former  
 dues & debts & mortgages & mortgages & from all manner of incumbrances whatsoever  
 What by the said Barnaby Drake & Mary his wife will hereby warrant & defend the same  
 to the said Mourning & Patty Drake their heirs & assigns against the lawful claim of all  
 manner of person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the s<sup>d</sup> Barnaby Drake Son & Mary  
 his wife hath hereunto set their hands & affix their seals the day & year a line written  
 Signed sealed & delivered in the
