This Indenture made this 7 day of Jan^y in the year of our Lord 1794 between Beverly Booth & Eliza his wife of Sten County of the one part & Allen Rogers of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that he said Beverly Booth & wife for and in consideration of the sum of £120 Current money of Eng^l to him in hand paid before the sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said Beverly Booth & wife hath bargained & sold Allen Rogers his heirs forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Sten on the south side of the Lightwood swamp being part of a tract whereon the said Beverly Booth now lieth bounded as follows viz Beginning at a black gum in Windhorns branch on James Johnsons line S 38 W to a red oak pine a corner thence S 62 E along the said Johnsons line to a Lightwood post a corner thence S 13 E to a lightwood post thence a new made line of marked trees a dividing line between the above Booth & Rogers S 30 W to a small pine a corner in Brittain Travis's line thence North along the said Travis's line to a Lightwood post thence N 53 W to a Willow Oak in Windhorns branch & down the various courses of the said branch to the beginning containing 200 Acres more or less together with all the profits privileges & appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises belonging in any wise appertaining to have & hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances unto the aforesaid Allen Rogers & his heirs forever & the said Beverly Booth & Eliza his wife the said tract or parcel of land & every part thereof again of themselves & against every other person or persons claiming under them or any of them to the said Allen Rogers his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant & never defend by then presents In Witness whereof the said Beverly Booth & Eliza his wife hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year first above written
