They the said Joseph Scott W^m Edwards & Joshua Beale have granted bargain'd sell or over alien enfeoff'd lease & confirm unto the said W^m Fowler his heirs & assigns forever all that plantation tract & parcel of land situate lying & being in the shire & county of Shenandoah of Northway containing 120 acres be the same more or less & bounded as follow to wit beginning at a pine standing at the mouth of the deep branch thence up the run of the branch to a small oak in fork of the said branch thence along a line of marked trees West 10 poles to a small black oak in Jonas Edwards line thence along his line north 10 degrees West 19 poles to a pine thence north 29 degrees west 22 poles to a small pine in Benj^m Beale's line thence along his line north 62 degrees East 47 poles to a pine thence south 87 degrees East to a dead oak in Low grounds of Black water river thence south 68 degrees East 4 1/2 poles to the beginning with all houses outhouses edifices buildings woods ways waters & water courses profits commodities hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining & the reason & reasoner's remainder & remainders rents issues profits & all the estates right title Interest claim or demand of them the said Joseph Scott William Edwards & Joshua Beale for and to the same or any part or parcel thereof to have and to hold the said plantation tract & parcel of 120 acres of land aforesaid unto him the said William Fowler his heirs & assigns forever & the said Joseph Scott William Edwards & Joshua Beale their heirs & assigns the one hundred & twenty acres of land more or less & premises with all singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto him the said William Fowler his heirs & assigns forever against them the said Joseph Scott William Edwards & Joshua Beale their heirs & assigns against all persons whatsoever claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof shall & well warrant & firm defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Joseph Scott William Edwards & Joshua Beale have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals the day & year first above written signed seal & delivered
