thence South 60 degrees West 173 poles to a red oak thence South 15 degrees West 39 poles to
the beginning To have and to hold the said 102 1/2 Acres of Land together with all the
appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining & all the privileges to the only
proper use of him the said Lewis Harris his heirs & assigns forever free from the let
hindrance or incumbrance of him the said Lewis Harris his heirs or assigns or any other
person or persons claiming the same by from or under him the said Lewis Harris his heirs

July 29th 1793 This day Mr Mary Nicholson & Benj^m Barham made the following agreement. To wit having each of them acct^d & against each other. Mr Nicholson agrees to give up all acct^s against the said Barham to this day except the hire of Negro Bob provided he would give up a Negro boy nam'd Lewis for life time & then to be left his will to the s^d Barham's two children namely Polly & Nancy Barham to be theirs or their heirs or to the surviving one of the two but if the said two children both die before the said Mr Nicholson then they are at the disposal of the said Mr Nicholson to whom he pleases To which we do hereby both agree to the above & do hereby solemnly swear & seal.
