This Indenture made this 3 day of February 1794 Between J^s Bryant of Wm of the one part & State of Vir^a of the one part & Benj^a Worrell (Jr) of s^t county & State of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Bryant for and in consideration of the sum of £500wert money of Vir^a to him in hand paid before sealing & delivering of these presents hath bargained sold & deliverd & doeth by these presents bargain sell & deliver unto the said Benjamin Worrell a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the county of s^t containing by Estimation Forty four acres & the same more or less bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a pine a corner tree in Richard Land thence along the said Williams line to a black Jack a corner tree in Andrew Mials Land thence along the said Mials line to a pine a corner tree in Jacob Mials land thence along the said Mials line to a pine a corner tree in Benj^a Worrells (Jr) land thence along the said Worrell line to a pine a corner in Richard Williams Land thence along the S. Williams line to the Beginning To have and to hold the said land & premises above mentioned with appurtenances unto the s^d Benjamin Worrell his heirs & assigns forever shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said J^s Bryant hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & year above written
