

In obedience to a summons to us directed Samuel Lawrence Nick Edmunds or any two of the Justices of the Peace for the county of Southampton of the State of North Carolina bearing date 9th day of July 1794 in the 18th year of the American Independence we have agreeably thereto taken the Examination of Susanna Daughtry wife of Jeremiah Daughtry at the house of the said Daughtry her husband who saith that she doth freely & voluntarily relinquish her right of dower in and to the premises mentioned in the said summons without the persuasion or threats of her husband & that she is willing that the same should be recorded in the county court of the said county under our hands & seals this 10th day of March 1794.

At a Court held for the county of Southampton the 4th day of February 1794— This deed was proved by the oaths of Jacob Lawrence Jacob Turner & Lewis Whitehead three of the witnesses thereto And at a court con^d held for the said county on the 17th of March 1794 the said Indenture with two commissions for the Privy Examination of the said Everitt wife of the said Everitt & of Susanna Daughtry wife of Jeremiah Daughtry parties thereto with certificates of their Execution were ordered to be recorded

This Indenture this 10th day of July in the year of our Lord 1793 Between John Magist^r of the County of Westford James Magist^r Etheldreda Everitt & Magist^r his wife Sam Magist^r of the State of Virginia & Jeremiah Daughtry & Susanna his wife & W^m Magist^r of North Carolina & Benjamin Magist^r of the same part & Nicholas Magist^r Jun^r of the county of Southampton of the other part & William Smith the latter in his wife & W^m Magist^r for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred pounds current money of Virginia to them with hand paid at or before the reading & delivery hereof the receipt whereof we solemnly acknowledge the said Nicholas Magist^r Jun^r then of the County of Southampton James Magist^r Etheldreda Everitt & Magist^r his wife Sam Magist^r Jeremiah Daughtry & Susanna his wife & W^m Magist^r do hereby acquit & discharge both granted bargain & sold release & compound & by this presents doth fully & absolutely grant bargain sell release & compound unto the said Nicholas Magist^r all our right title interest or claim of in and to one certain tract or parcel of Land being in the aforesaid county of Nam and on the North side of the Rappahannock River south side of Northway River containing 160 Acres more or less bounded as follows beginning at a byspring standing on the south side of the River of the byspring swamp to a corner tree formerly Alexander May Jun^r his land thence crossing the said swamp N^o East half of the said corner tree & corner tree land whereof Jacob Turner is now in possession thence on the said line to the byspring swamp & thence down the run of the said swamp to the Beginning the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land being part of a patent granted to William Turner dated June in the year of our Lord 1739 by the said Turner conveyed to James Macey by deed dated the 1st day of July 1740 who devised the same to his daughter Jane who intermarried with Nicholas Magist^r & departed
