This Indenture made this 10 day of April in the year of our Lord 1794. Between Jacob Darson Int. His wife Martha of Hen county Virg^a of the one part & James Loggin of the county and state aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the sd Jacob his wife Martha for and in consideration of the sum of £30 Virg^a currency to them in hand p^d by the undersigned & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge & themselves therewith fully satisfied contented and paid have granted bargain'd sold alien'd enj^d & confirm'd that these presents do grant bargain sell alien enj^d & confirm unto the said James Loggin his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying being situate in Hen county on the East side of the bypreps Swamp & about the head of the Cedar Marsh & bounded as followeth Beginning at a Juniper tree standing in the Cedar marsh a corner tree of Matthew Jones land running thence Northly out of the Marsh to a bypreps standing on the side thereof thence down the side of the Marsh to the mouth of the misery branch thence over thereof thence up the sd run to where Henry Gardens James Loggin & this said land meet thence binding on sd Loggin line to the Cedar Marsh thence up the marsh to the aforesaid bypreps standing on the side thereof thence binding on sd Loggin line to Henry Gardens line thence along sd line to a pine a corner tree foot of vacant Land thence along the line for said vacant land about a South course binding on sd vacant land & John Gardens land to a pine a corner tree standing in Matthew Jones line thence along sd Jones line to the several corners thereof to the station containing by Estimation 100 Acres more or less To have and to hold the said bargain'd premises with the sd p^d to him the sd James Loggin his heirs & assigns forever Together with all houses out houses woodways mines & minerals and all other the profits & common duties thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining & they the said Jacob Darson & Martha his wife for themselves their heirs & assigns do & will warrant & forever defend the sd bargain'd premises against the lawful claim claims of all & every person or persons living or hereafter to come the said James Loggin his heirs & assigns forever In Witness whereof they the said Jacob Darson & Martha his wife have sign'd seal'd acknowledged
